



### **ALL ABOUT WINGS**

WINGS started out as "Ladies of St. Isidore" in September of 2010. Clara Carroll led the group for several years. In July of 2015, when Sister Katherine was at St. Isidore, we voted to change the group's name to "Women in God's Service" or WINGS.

The mission of WINGS is to build community among the women of our parish through spiritual, social, and charitable activities with the help of the Blessed Virgin Mary as our patron and guide.

As "Women in God's Service," we try to find ways to serve God through others. WINGS was founded first and foremost as a service group, but we are more than that. As women coming together, we look to strengthen our spiritual life and to grow in understanding of God's will for our lives. Along the way, we have time for friendship, fun, and sharing some wonderful snacks and occasional luncheons.

WINGS meets monthly on the third Thursday of the month at 1:30pm in the St. Isidore Small Hall. The focus at meetings is on fellowship and spirituality. We open with prayer, have a spiritual presentation of some kind, occasionally have a guest speaker, discuss business issues, close with a prayer, and then share refreshments and conversation during social time.

Some of our past parish activities include the following: hosting a mother/daughter banquet several years ago, hosting the Winterfest Cafe for many years, working in the kitchen during the Knights of Columbus rummage sales for several years, hosting an appreciation dinner for the Knights, providing craft activities for kids at the Parish Picnic, and recently we started hosting the Parish Christmas Party. We have donated to the Laingsburg Food Bank, Catholic Charities, Christo Rey, Homeless Angels, Pregnancy Resource Center, the Elsie Baby Pantry, and collected and donated school supplies as part of our charitable activities.
